

How to fold your quilt

Option 1

First up fold your quilt in half top to bottom and then in thirds - like the picture.



Then you sort of fold/roll the quilt up and I try to make it so that the label is on the top when they open the box.



This is one of the last personalised label I did. It got way too stressful trying to make sure the right label was on the right quilt top when we were layering 10 or more quilts at a time.



As this laundry bag has initials on it I have folded it so that those are on the top.



You can see there is just enough room to tuck a packet of Timtams down the side of the box before it gets posted off.



Option 2

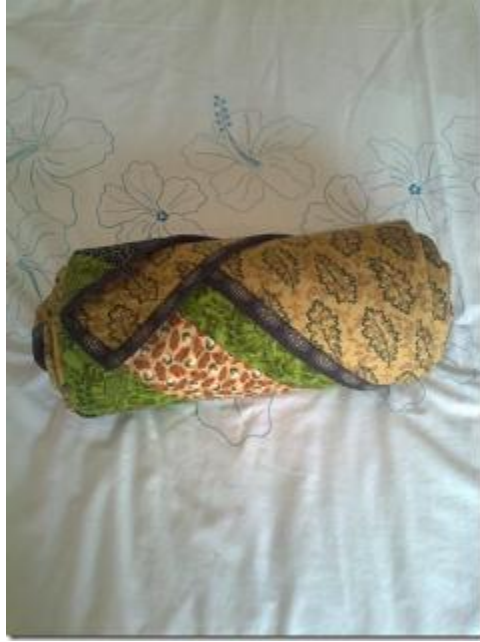
The aim of this fold is to end up with a roll that matches the width of the box so as you are folding make sure you are ending up with the right width.
